
### 6th anniversary of SSHADE and how to change your e-mail login

Dear SSHADE users,

We are celebrating this month the 6th anniversary of the public launch of SSHADE. SSHADE has evolved significantly over the past years and is now a very rich infrastructure.

Currently, SSHADE hosts 20 active databases with an additional 8 in the initial phase. The platform encompasses over 7,500 spectra from over 3,000 solid samples, including ices, minerals, rocks, meteorites, and more. Moreover, in 2021, SSHADE has expanded its capabilities by introducing a new component—the band list database. A 'band list' comprises parameters such as position, width, intensity, and vibration modes of molecules, minerals, or ionic/covalent solids. SSHADE now boasts a collection of 64 band lists.

For our longest-standing users, your email address may have changed over this time. That's why, on this anniversary, we want to remind you how to update your login email address. Once logged in, the first thing to do is click on 'Profile and Settings.'
